

How do I get a U.S. visa?

Beginning November 12, 2014, visa applicants in the Dominican Republic will follow these six easy steps.

Visit santodomingo.usembassy.gov/visas.html to learn more.

Fill out the DS-160 application form online at ceac.state.gov

- Your name and birthdate should appear exactly as in your passport.
- Answer every question to the best of your ability.

Visit www.ustraveldocs.com

- Create a profile with your biographic information and choose your document delivery location.
- Select your visa class and print the confirmation with the amount you will pay at Banco Popular.

Pay the application fee at Banco Popular

- The fee is only payable in Dominican pesos.
- You will need the receipt number to make an appointment.
- The one-time fee covers appointment scheduling, interview, and delivery.

Make your appointment at www.ustraveldocs.com

- Make appointments at both the Visa Application Center and at the United States Embassy.
- Some applicants may require only one appointment at the Visa Application Center or may be eligible for free mail-in service via Mailboxes, Etc.

Go to the Visa Application Center

- The VAC is located in Galeria 360 on Ave. John F. Kennedy.
- Bring your passport, receipt of payment, and DS-160 confirmation page.
- VAC staff will take your photo and fingerprints.

Attend interview at U.S. Embassy

- Plan to arrive no more than 15 minutes before your appointment time.
- Bring your passport and any documents needed to support your application.
- Pick up passport and visa at Mailboxes, Etc. location.
