The Contractor shall maintain the following systems in a safe, reliable and efficient operating condition.

- 1) Five (5) York AHU (TCP-245, TCP-300, TCP-165)
- 2) Two (2) Johnson FCU (F-HP)

The Contractor shall provide all necessary managerial, administrative and direct labor personnel, as well as all transportation, equipment, tools, supplies and materials required to perform inspection, maintenance, and component replacement as required to maintain the systems in accordance with the Statement of Work.

The Contractor shall provide the services of trained and qualified technicians to inspect, adjust, and perform scheduled preventive maintenance; and provide consumable materials.


The chillers should be clean and in good operating condition upon completion of the service.
