The Embassy of the United States of America requires contracting a company that shall provide preventive maintenance services for their fuel systems at the American Consulate located at Calle Santa Ana y Av. José Rodríguez Bonin, Sector San Eduardo in Guayaquil, Ecuador.

The Contractor shall maintain the following systems in a safe, reliable and efficient operating condition.

- 1) Pump Control Panel- Simplex 8-A System Total
- 2) Tank Management/Liquid Control System- Pneumarcator TMS-300
- 3) Pump Control Box- Red Jacket/Veeder Root Company 880-042
- 4) Submersible Pumps (4)- Red Jacket 1.5 HP

The Contractor shall provide all materials, supervision, labor, tools and equipment to perform preventive maintenance. Consulate staff has service manuals for the Fuel System on site All personnel working in the vicinity shall wear and /or use safety protection while all work is performed. Any questions or injuries shall be brought to the attention of the Post Occupation Safety and Health Officer (POSHO). Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) shall be provided by the Contractor for all HAZMAT materials.

**Duration of the contract:**

The resultant contract will be a fixed price contract for one base year and four one-year option periods (possibility of a five-year contract) to be exercised at the option of the US Government.
