

## **Contract Requirement –**

### **CONSTRUCTION OF KENNELS FOR THE ANTINARCOTICS POLICE UNIT IN GUAYAQUIL PORT- ECUADOR**

#### **Background**

The U.S. Embassy in Quito, Ecuador, has a requirement for the construction of 20 kennels for the Antinarcotics Police Unit of Guayaquil Port - Ecuador.

The construction of the kennels will be performed in a plot located inside the Antinarcotics facilities that is being developed in “Autoridad Portuaria” at Guayaquil Port – Ecuador. The area of this new building is 200 m2.

#### **Estimated Range of Project:**

Between \$25,000 to \$100,000

#### **Timeframe for the Execution:**

The timeframe for the execution of the construction is three months that will start when a complete notice to proceed is submitted to the contractor.

#### **General Information required from interested firms:**

The Offers for the construction of this project shall include the following:

- Name of the company, name of the legal representative, address, telephone, cellular phone, e-mail.
- Standard form 1442: Includes the total cost of the offer including IVA tax.
- Proposed Work Information
- Past Performance Experience

In addition to the aforementioned, the following is required of all potential contractors:

- Must be able to understand written and spoken English.
- Have an established business with a permanent address and telephone listing.
- Have the necessary personnel, equipment and financial resources available to perform the work.
- Have all licenses and permits required by local law.
- Meet all local insurance requirements.
- Have the ability to obtain a performance and guarantee bond and a payment bond, or to post adequate security, such as irrevocable letters of credit or guarantees issued by a reputable financial institution.
- Have no adverse criminal record.
- Have no political or business affiliation which could be considered contrary to the interests of the United States.
- Identify specialized experience and technical competence required to construct the aforementioned project.
