Question 1: In Exhibit A para (scheduled preventive maintenance)(monthly & quarterly)(general): Will the contractor be reimbursed for the value of the supply expendable parts like hoses, filters, gaskets, thermostat, belts, coolant, oil, fuses and gaskets as all the supply will be left on site as residual material? *No Reimbursement for expendable supplies, it's a part of labor and material for cost of BME. Contractor is responsible for supplying expendable parts such as hoses, filters, gaskets, thermostat, belts, coolant, oil, fuses and gaskets etc. Yes expendable supplies will be stored onsite. All used parts must be removed from site and disposed properly by contractor.*

Question 2: Kindly provide us with the following clarification:

- ✚ **Pumps quantity data sheets required for preventive maintenance.**
If you are referring to submersible fuel pumps then NO, they are not included in this contract.
- ✚ **Serial and arrangement number of the engines of all the generators.**
Refer to solicitation Description of Equipment Section B.4.1 Schedule Maintenance Service.
- ✚ **Complete shop drawing (Single line diagram, Power circuits, Control circuits and layout) for ATS panels.**
Available in Embassy for reference only cannot be disclosed to general public.
- ✚ **Bid Bond amount required as guarantee.**
Please refer to H.3.1 The Contractor shall furnish (1) a performance and guaranty bond on forms provided by and from sureties acceptable to the Government, each in the amount of 10% of the contract price.
- ✚ **Please confirm that the standard spare parts for preventive maintenance shall be included in our offer.**
YES, please include cost of all expendable parts in your quote.
- ✚ **Custom declaration for all spare parts will be United State Embassy Cairo responsibility, Please confirm. No, contractors are responsible for getting all parts and clear them from customs.**
No, contractors are responsible for getting all parts and clearing them through customs. US Embassy will provide the required Ministry of Foreign Affairs clearance ppwk to guarantee Duty Free entry provided goods are shipped in the name of US Embassy.

Question 3: Company requests an extension for three week from the due date to fulfill all tender specs and submit best competitive offer.

Deadline for receiving the offers has been extended for ONE Week. New deadline will be March 30th @ 2:00 pm as per below SF-30.



Question 4: In section B in B.4.1 in the table, please define and explain (unit price / service)? Does that mean how much would the monthly service cost? Quarterly service cost? Semi-annual service cost? Annual service cost? Otherwise when the contractor will price should they price every service in detail? And also if we divided the year into 12 month, which service you want to begin in the first month?

This is a firm fixed price contract which includes all four services Monthly, Quarterly, Semi-annual and Annual service cost as lump sum. We will start with Monthly service and go on.

Question 5: In Exhibit A para (scheduled preventive maintenance) (monthly & quarterly)(general): The Contractor shall inventory, supply and replace expendable parts (filters, belts, hoses, gaskets) that have become worn down due to wear and tear. The Contractor shall maintain a supply of expendable and common parts on site so that these are readily available for normal maintenance to include: hoses, belts, oil, chemicals, coolant, filters (Air, Fuel, Oil), generator starting batteries, grease, sealant, thermostat, fuses; in addition to the appropriate tools, testing equipment, safety shoes and apparel for technicians, personal protective equipment (hands, hearing, eye protection), MSDS, cleaning material and oil spill containment kits. The contractor should inventory the supply after each visit and order replacement supplies and have the delivered to post.)

Second line mentions gaskets as expendable parts, which gaskets do this part refer to? Any gaskets and kits in the generator like cylinder head gasket, lubrication pan gasket? Does this type of Gasket mean main gaskets OR secondary and small gaskets like turbo charger gasket, manifold gasket? OR all types of gaskets upper and lower?

Secondary and small gaskets like turbo charger gasket, manifold gasket etc. All major types of gaskets will be included in under separate Purchase Order.

Question 6: Line NO.4 mentions in detail types of expendable parts (hoses, belts....) but does not mention gasket? Please explain and if available please list expendable parts in detail?

Contractor is responsible for supplying expendable parts such as hoses, filters, gaskets, thermostat, belts, coolant, oil, fuses, gaskets nuts bolts etc. to complete the maintenance and put the generators and ATS back in service.
