## *FORTUNE/ State Department Global Women's Mentoring Program*

### Description:

The U.S. State Department and *Fortune* Most Powerful Women are proud to announce a partnership with the Office of the First Lady on the Let Girls Learn Initiative for the 2016 program. This public-private partnership places talented, emerging women leaders from all over the world in mentoring programs with *Fortune*'s Most Powerful Women Leaders. Over the past ten years, the program has connected women from around the world with executive women mentors from the *Fortune* Most Powerful Women community, resulting in the expansion of professional networks and skill development opportunities for the emerging leaders. This year, the partnership also supports the Let Girls Learn Initiative by convening women leaders around the issue of adolescent girls' education. The four-week mentoring program will take place **May 2 through May 25, 2016**.

### Eligibility:

Emerging self-motivated women leaders in the business and non-profit sectors as well as women who have worked in adolescent girls' education or demonstrated passion for adolescent girls' education and empowerment, between the ages of 25 and 43 with a very good command of English. Women who run their own businesses, work in the middle/ middle-upper management of a non-U.S.-based corporation or women who run business associations, foundations or non-governmental organizations, especially with a focus on adolescent girls' education and empowerment. Individuals who work for Fortune 500 companies are not eligible.
