

Demonstration Notice March 6, 2011

Please be aware of the planned demonstrations and large gatherings indicated below planned over the next five days. However, spontaneous demonstrations and clashes are still capable of taking place.

- Sunday, 06 March:

- Demonstrators are planning to gather and pitch tents near the Financial Harbor.

- Monday, 07 March:

- At approximately 9:00 AM, a sit-in is scheduled to take place near the U.S. Embassy.

- At approximately 3:00 PM, a demonstration is planned near the Ministry of Interior – Criminal Investigative Division offices in the Adliya area.

- Wednesday, 09 March:

- Demonstrators are planning to gather near the Ras Rumman Mosque and then move to the General Directorate of Nationality, Passports and Residence in the Diplomatic Area.

- Thursday, 10 March:

- At approximately 3:00 PM, a demonstration is planned in front of the United Nations offices in the Diplomatic Area.

- Friday, 11 March:

- Demonstrators are planning to gather at the Driving Training School near Isa Town and then move to the Royal Court in Riffa.

- There continue to be on-going demonstrations near the Pearl Roundabout, and numerous demonstrations have been reported at the Salmaniya Medical Center in recent days.

US Citizens are advised to avoid those areas.
