

American Resource Center Moves to Kaisa House

The Kaisa House in Kaisaniemi represents state-of-the-art, award-winning Finnish library architecture. The Helsinki University Main Library in Kaisa House is the most ambitious project of the Helsinki World Design Capital year. It has been awarded the 2012 Critics' Spurs award.

The surface area of the new building is 15,500 square metres. The building was completed on May Day eve 2012 and the library was opened for customer use on the 3rd of September 2012 when the university term began.

The library is open to all and it offers equal access to the sources of scientific information.

ARC at the Kaisa House


During the summer 2012, the ARC moved to the Helsinki University Main Library in Kaisa House. We are located in the 2nd floor of the new library.
