Register your trip with the U.S. Consulate General

All American citizens traveling to France should enroll with the embassy ahead of their travels using the [Smart Traveler Enrollment Program](#) (STEP).

U.S. Passport Validity for Travel to France

You should have at least six months' passport validity prior to the expiration date whenever you travel to France.

If your passport does not meet the [Schengen requirements](#), you may be refused boarding by the airline at your point of origin or while transferring planes. You could also be denied entry when you arrive in the [Schengen area](#).
