Optional: When renewing your passport, all U.S. citizens may also apply for a passport card. The U.S. Passport Card can be used to enter the United States from Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean, and Bermuda at land border crossings or sea ports-of-entry and is more convenient and less expensive than a passport book. **The passport card cannot be used for international travel by air.**

For Passport Card Applications:

- **Complete online and submit Form DS-82** available using the [online passport wizard](#). Be sure to answer all questions accurately as any mistakes may result in a delay. **Check that you are using the correct form here** (PDF 202 kb). Print one-sided pages only, sign and date.**
- Check the appropriate box(es) on the top of the application Form DS-82:
[U.S. Passport Book] [U.S. Passport Card] [Both]
- Fee for U.S. Passport Card: Supplementary fee (**27 Euros**). ([See fees and payment methods](#)).

If you are applying for **both** the passport book **and** the passport card you must submit:

- **TWO U.S. passport photographs**, and
- **TWO Chronopost envelopes****.

**** Passport cards processing takes about 3 to 4 weeks more than a passport book. If you would like the consulate to hold your passport book until the card is ready, please include a note to clearly state that you would like to receive both at the same time and in the same Chronopost envelope.**
