The Embassy of the United States of America has a requirement for a firm to perform electrical works at the Ambassador’s residence in Paris. It is anticipated that the range in price of this contract will be between \$250,000 and \$500,000 and needs to be completed by September 2013, in Paris, France.

This Electrical Upgrade work comprises the replacement of power panels and their terminal cabling in four different floors of the residence.

All firms that respond to the solicitation must be technically qualified and financially responsible to perform the work. At a minimum, each offeror must meet the following requirements when submitting their proposal:

- Be able to understand written and spoken English;
- Have an established business with a permanent address and telephone listing;
- Have the necessary personnel, equipment and financial resources available to perform the work;
- Have all licenses and permits required by local law;
- Meet all local insurance requirements;
- Have the ability to obtain a performance and guarantee bond and a payment bond, or to post adequate performance security, such as irrevocable letters of credit or guarantees issued by a reputable financial institution;
- Have no adverse criminal record;
- Have no political or business affiliation which could be considered contrary to the interests of the United States;
- Have good experience and past performance records;

- Identify specialized experience and technical competence required to complete the construction work in accordance with this solicitation; and
- Have electrical qualifications related to this project.
