*Tbilisi, Georgia* – The U.S. Embassy in Georgia announces the opening of the Book Translation Program for 2011.

The Public Affairs Section of the U.S. Embassy is soliciting proposals from publishing houses and academic institutions to translate of textbooks and/or books for general public interest by American authors under the following themes:

- **Public Policy:** general public policy, also public policy on issues related to the environment, agriculture, health, and education management.
- **Public Administration:** general public administration, and related topics such as statistics, research methodologies, non-profit management, fund-raising, etc.
- **Media:** media ethics, media management, mass communication and related topics.
- **International Relations:** international relations, foreign policy, and related topics.
- **Law:** international law, intellectual property rights, jury trials, and related topics.
- **Economics:** business administration, economics, and related topics.
