The police reported that Reforma Avenue (south bound) is completely blocked due to an attack on a school bus from Colegio Bilingüe Vista Hermosa at approximately 3:15 p.m. To our knowledge, there were no American students involved in the incident. At this time, we know of no disruption to regular school bus service.
