A Digital Path to Entrepreneurship and Innovation for Latin America

The International Center for Journalists (ICFJ) is recruiting professional and citizen journalists, media business managers, digital entrepreneurs, and technologists to create media business models that use digital tools to generate sustainable new revenue.

The selected Latin American fellows will complete a month-long program in the United States which begins with an orientation at ICFJ's headquarters. Each fellow will then participate in a three-week individualized internship at carefully selected U.S. institutions, matched with expert U.S. counterparts. Applicants must be fluent in English.

The host organizations include traditional media and new digital media start-ups, and institutions that invent digital tools to pioneer ways to deliver news and information and serve the public interest. Past hosts include Mother Jones, Slate Magazine, Fusion, Splash Media, and AJ+.

The fellows will be immersed in the latest of the digital world. They will also experience the diversity of U.S. life through events and opportunities. The program concludes with a 3-day Professional Fellows Congresses in Washington, D.C. The U.S. fellows will later go to the participants' countries to work with them and experience life and culture there.

Selection will be based on professional qualifications, relevant experience, English proficiency, leadership potential, and commitment to enhancing mutual understanding between the people of their countries.

Fellows must travel on J-1 visas. If a person cannot obtain a J-1 visa, they won't be able to participate. All expenses will be paid (travel, activity costs, visa application fee), and participants will have accident and sickness insurance during their exchange.
