

José Rodríguez Bonín, Guayaquil, Ecuador on or before Friday, September 5, 2014 at 12h00. No proposal will be accepted after this time.

The U.S. Government intends to award a contract/purchase order to the responsible company submitting an acceptable quotation at the lowest price. We intend to award a contract/purchase order based on initial quotations, without holding discussions, although we may hold discussions with companies in the competitive range if there is a need to do so.
