The Agency for International Development in Haiti invites applications for the position of **Infrastructure and Public Health Systems Coordinator (H&E)**, at the **FSN-12 Level**. The Infrastructure and Public Health Systems Coordinator is responsible for providing expert advice in the areas of infrastructure and health systems to support the establishment and/or strengthening of health referral networks. Entry level might be lower depending on qualifications. Job description is available at USAID/Personnel Office and the deadline for receiving applications is **January 20, 2012**.

Required Qualifications:

Education: Doctoral level degree required and master level degree in public health, health policy business public administration or related field preferred.

Experience: Minimum eight (8) years of relevant experience to governance and decentralization of the management of health services, or other public health programs.

Language: Fluency in written and spoken English (Level IV), French and Creole are required.

Knowledge: Must have good knowledge of current health systems governance and infrastructure issues and interventions; detailed knowledge of the GOH health care system and structures.

Skills: Strong leadership and communication skills. Ability to analyze, understand and discuss new program design, management and implementation approaches. Able to produce results within tight deadlines. Good computer skills.
