World Learning places Global UGRAD participants in US colleges and universities to strengthen their leadership and professional skills while they explore core US values and culture.

General Eligibility Requirement

- Must be 18 years of age.
- Applicant must be a citizen, national, or permanent resident qualified to hold a valid passport issued by the country from which the applicant is applying.
- Applicant must be able to receive and maintain a J-1 visa.
- Participants must be committed to returning to their home country after completion of the program.
