

PRESOLICITATION NOTICE: POLICE ACADEMY WALL CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

CONTRACTING OFFICE: US EMBASSY-PORT AU PRINCE-NAS

This project includes, design, demolition, and new construction for the Police Academy Wall at the Port du Price facility. The Contractor shall be solely responsible for providing design, construction services, contract coordination, and supervision. It includes, but not limited to the management, professional services, design services, all labor, material, and equipment necessary to meet the requirements of this task order within the established schedules, and in accordance with all of the main contract requirements. Contract will include one design submittal.

Schedule delivery is a critical component in the execution of this project, and special attention shall be placed on the safety practices of the Contractor. All debris materials proceeding from the demolition work shall be put at the disposition of the Contractor and any salvaged materials shall be dispensed for Contractor's use. The Contractor shall utilize host nation support equipment and local contingency contracting for equipment and material to the maximum extent possible, but shall be prepared to import tools, equipment for demolition and construction (including light and heavy construction equipment), materials, and test equipment required to conduct the objective of this SOW.

This project is unclassified and no security clearances are required. Host Nation Authorizations, Permits and Licenses

It shall be the Contractor's responsibility to obtain such local authorizations, permits and licenses necessary to complete the project and/or mobilization and life support activities.

The Contractor shall be responsible for securing all of the required permits from the following agencies:

- A. Municipality and the Ministry of Public Works,
- B. National Direction of Potable Water and Sewage
- C. Ministry of Public Works, Transports and Communications (MTPTC) - Electricity

Limit of Construction

The Contract includes work within the Haitian Government property line and limited additional work extending into the adjacent city streets and public rights-of-ways. Local host country Site Planning approvals are not required.

PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE: 180 DAYS

ESTIMATED VALUE: Not to exceed (NTE) \$1,000,000.
