

Visa A

Diplomats Employees Diplomats / Employees International Organizations

For diplomats, employees of diplomatic missions, as well as employees of international organizations such as the United Nations or the Organization of American States. They must travel to the United States by his government in compliance only official activities for the government. Officials of local government representing your state, province, municipality or other entities do not qualify for this type of Visa.

Visa A-1: Ambassador, public minister, career, diplomatic or consular officer, and members of immediate family

Visa A-2: Other foreign government official or employee, and members of immediate family.

Visa A-3: Attendant, servant, or personal employee of A-1 and A-2, and members of immediate family.

Important notes:

Officials foreigners wishing to travel to the United States for official business must obtain a visa prior to their entry. They may not travel with a tourism visa or without a visa if you qualify for the program Visa Waiver. "

Government officials traveling to the United States to play a non-governmental tourism or require a visa type B, they do not qualify for a diplomatic visa.

People who have diplomatic passports are exempt from any type of visa. People with official passports do not pay for official visas, but when I apply for visas unofficial, it must cover the fees for processing and issuance in cases that apply.

Relatives are defined as immediate wife and unmarried children of any age-dependent applicant. The wife and children of the principal applicant are eligible to apply for visas dependent (although spouses in free union are not accepted for visa purposes American). Companions who are recognized as dependents of the applicant by the government that sends them, but are not eligible for a visa Type A, may request a B-1/B-2 visa, if they are eligible for it. A B-1/B-2 visa applicants are

required to pay for processing, and the share of reciprocity on the same show if they are of one nationality in which it applies.
