

VISA B

Visitors for Business and Tourists

B-1 Visa: For temporary visitors for business. Includes traders or company representatives who travel to the United States for purposes of making sales, attend meetings or conferences and exploring new businesses and carriers.

Domestic Workers Assistants or accompanying an employer, or who are already in the United States with a visa B, E, F, H, I, J, L, M, O, P, Q, R or are eligible for a visa B-1 filing:

- The empelado has been recruited outside the United States at least one year old.
- Have at least one year's experience as a domestic worker
- Domestic Employees wishing to accompany a pattern Citizen of the United States may be eligible for a B-1 if the pattern normally resides outside the United States and travels through temporary periods to the United States. **Note:** Unable to qualify for a B-1 if the U.S. citizen residing permanently in the United States, although in the applicant has previously worked with the employer outside the country.

B-2 Visa: For tourists, foreigners who enter the United States for vacation and leisure travelers. Not permitted to work or study. The B-2 also given to people who travel for medical treatment.

B1/B2 Visa: It is a combination of these two types of visas.

Show BBBCC: It is a combination of the visa B1 and B2 with a border crossing card, better known as LASER VISA.

BBBCV Visa: It is a combination of the visa B1 and B2 with a border crossing card which is stamped on the passport Mexican: this visa is granted when a laser visa has been stolen or lost, and in special situations (prior authorization a Vice Consul).
