

# VISAS G

## Employees of governments or international organizations

**G-1 Visa:** For government representatives who work in international organizations whose headquarters are in the United States, as for example: United Nations (UN), Organization of American States (OAS), World Bank (WB), Fund International Monetary (IMF), International Red Cross, etc.. Including staff members of the bearer of the visa and their immediate families (spouse and children).

**G-2 Visa:** For other government employees working in international organizations such as accredited representatives of governments and members of their families, who will be incorporated into the work of an international organization whose headquarters is located in the United States.

**G-3 Visa:** For delegates or representatives of governments that do not belong to international organizations, but traveling to the United States to attend events or activities of institutions worldwide. Covering immediate family (wife and children).

**G-4 Visa:** To officials of international organizations whose headquarters is located in the United States and their immediate families.

**G-5 Visa:** To support personnel or service (and their immediate families) of all staff visa holders type G.

### **Important Note:**

For this type of visa applicants must submit a letter diplomatically.
