

## Questions and Answers

### Solicitation SOL-522-15-000022 Infrastructure Assessment

1. Does USAID/ Honduras have contacts within the communities /areas to be visited, to serve as liaison for the consulting team?

A.1 We can provide (along with FHIS) community contacts in areas to be visited. But USAID cannot guarantee their willingness to serve in an official liaison capacity.

2. Is it possible to expand the 2 month period for the project? In order to warranty the quantity and quality all the results in all the areas established in the project.

A.2 No, the project end date is firm.

3. Regarding for the logistics, will USAID/Honduras be providing security for the consulting team staff as well as a liaison in the community? This considering the areas have a heavy gang presence.

A.3 USAID/Honduras will not provide security for the consulting team. See #1 for information on community liaisons.

4. Is there a chance to extend the time frame to present the offers? At least an additional week.

A.4 No, offers are due on the date stipulated in the RFP.

5. The professional propose by our company as Team Leader, is fluent in English reading, writing and oral understanding, but is regular about conversation. Please, confirm that, if he/she have these parameters, he/she may be incorporated into that position.

A. 5 Yes, we will be flexible on the level of spoken English proficiency for the Team Leader, particularly if other team members have a demonstrated proficiency in English.

6. We request to reconsider the stipulated payment, considering that in order perform the activities, it is necessary provide logistics to our assigned staff, for example travel expenses.

A.6 USAID/ Honduras could arrange for a 25% payment upon approval of the work plan. The remaining 75% would be paid upon the receipt and acceptance of the final report.
