

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR A/E SERVICES

Architectural services for the renovation of an existing office building in Tegucigalpa, Honduras; estimated project cost between \$100,000.00 and \$250,000.00.

Firms responding to this announcement on or before closing date will be considered for selection using the following evaluation criteria in descending order of importance:

- Relevant, professional qualifications of the firm in the type of work required in the past three years. Relevant experience is considered to be designs performed to U.S. Government standards either in DOD or DOS design review system PROJNET. A U.S. Government standard design includes, but is not limited to: Following A/E/C CAD standard for AUTOCAD layer naming, editing US Government performance based specifications using SPECSINTACT, and performing technical analysis for each discipline following NEC, NFPA 101, NFPA 72 and OBO standards criteria for each applicable discipline.
- Specialized experience and technical competence in the type of work required. Firms should provide proposed designers of records curriculums for each discipline considered to be needed. As a minimum Firms should provide information regarding: architectural / civil engineer project manager, electrical engineer, and fire protection engineer.
- Demonstrated success on similar projects in terms of quality of work and compliance with performance schedules, cost/schedule controls and program/project management techniques. Briefly describe internal quality assurance and cost control procedures and indicate effectiveness by listing budget/estimated construction cost, award amount, final design estimate and construction changes for five recent projects. Although previous or ongoing performance of a similar U.S. Government contract is preferred, but not required for firms responding to this solicitation; if such contracts have been performed, the firm must have performed at a satisfactory level; and
- Licenses such as the Operations Permit, “accreditation of the Colegio de Arquitectos” or “Colegio de Ingenieros de Honduras (CICH)”

The Embassy will select for negotiation the licensed firm that demonstrates the best qualifications.
