- 1. For the coating should anything have to be taken off?**  
Just dirt and loose material over the roof membrane. You do not need to remove the roof membrane.
- 2. What things does the Embassy provide and what things can bring the workers?**  
**A/** a.Elastomeric primer coating (silver/gray)-Embassy provided  
b.Elastomeric Flashing Grade seam sealer (white) -Embassy provided  
c.Elastomeric finish coating (white) -Embassy provided  
d.Polyester seam fabric (150mm (6inch) & 300 mm (12inch) -Embassy provided  
e.The contractor must bring all the necessary installation tools and supplies: rollers, brushes, buckets, spatulas etc.
- 3. Does the Embassy require warranty in prices?**  
**A/** Prices in quotation should be maintained, please consider that work will start approximately 3-6 months after Contract is awarded.
- 4. What kind of labor warranty does the Embassy requires?**  
**A /** No warranties required but please see 5.1in SOW. The Embassy reserves the right to require the contractor to redo the work in areas where the labor was not performed satisfactorily.
- 5. What if in some areas material has to be taken off?**  
In essence, No material has to be taken off.
- 6. Can work be done on Saturdays?**  
**A/**We may try to schedule some work on Saturday, but it will not be every week.
- 7. Is the rainy season considered for the time of deliver?**  
**A/** No
- 8. What would be the width of the fiber?**  
**A/** 12" and 6"
- 9. Are the measures accurate?**  
**A/**Yes.
- 10. Can we quote by square meters?**  
**A/**Yes, you must.
- 11. Will you instruct the company in the procedure of application of the coating?**  
**A/**The procedure is very clear in the SOW. Should there be questions at the time of application, the COR will gladly help.
- 12. The offer must be in lempiras or dollars?**  
**A/** Dollars
- 13. Does the coating application include the corners of the wall?**  
Yes, the parapet walls must be coated.
- 14. What documents will we need to bring at the time to work?**  
**A/** Honduran ID
- 15. The payment will be made in U.S. dollars?**  
**A/** Payment is made in the currency quoted.
- 16. When can the embassy make the payment?**  
**A/** Payments are made 15 days after work is done; but payments can be made in installments.

**17. When will we know to whom the contract is awarded?**

A/ Between August 30 – September 3, 2013.

**18. Are there water supplies connections?**

A/ yes

**19. Is it necessary to pressure wash the roof?**

A/ No

**20. What will be the schedule of work?**

A/9:30-11:00AM Monday – Friday

1:00PM -4:00PM –Monday-Thursday

1:00PM -3:00PM-Friday

Some Saturdays from 8-11 if escort is available

**21. How many workers are allowed per escort?**

A/4-5

**22. Where will the tools be kept?**

A/ In a storage room at the roof

**23. Should we do a proof for the work that it has been done?**

A/No.

**24. Can the supervisor be at the work area?**

A/ yes, but if this is the case he/she is also counted as an escorted personnel.

**25. Can you provide technical information on the product or can you give the web page where we can download the information?**

A/ No, the product has not been purchased yet.

**26. What is the time of curing between finishing coats?**

A/minimum 24 hours between coats.

**27. Tools needed have to be considered in our offer, the embassy will only supply the product itself, is this correct?**

A/ Yes, Embassy will only provide the product.
