





Little, Brown & Company, 2001

A 1951 novel by J. D. Salinger that has become popular with adolescent readers for its themes of teenage confusion, angst, alienation, and rebellion. The narrator, protagonist and anti-hero Holden Caulfield has been synonymous with "cynical adolescent." Holden narrates the story of a couple of days in his sixteen-year-old life, just after he's been expelled from prep school, in a slang that sounds edgy even today.

Prepare yourself for an iconoclastic survey of some of science's most notable discoveries that will transform the way you think about science and scientists. John Waller argues that scientific research is haphazard and less rational than is commonly believed. For example, Louis Pasteur suppressed data that didn't support his theories.
