If you intend to submit a quotation, you should thoroughly examine all documents contained in the contract solicitation package. Your quotation must be submitted with the contracting officer at newdelhibids@state.gov with the subject line "Solicitation for Fabrication, Supply and Installation of 12-kiloliter capacity Under Ground Petrol Storage Tanks at Chancery Compound of U.S. Embassy, New Delhi, India" **on or before 1700 hours of May 22, 2015. No quotation will be accepted after this time.**

Complete the OFFER portion of the Standard Form 1442 (block 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 20A, 20B & 20C), including all blank spaces, and have the form signed by an authorized representative of your company, or the quotation may be considered unacceptable and may be rejected.

In order for a quotation to be considered, you must also complete and submit the following:

1. Section B, prices (page # 2)
2. Bar Chart illustrating sequence of work to be performed;
3. CV for key personnel's to work on the project. Refer L.4.

4. CV of the technical team to work on this project. Refer L.4.
5. Profile of the contractor and sub-contractor who will actually execute the work with emphasis on similar kind of work experience. Refer H.13.2.
6. Additional information as required in Section L.
7. Section K, Representations and Certifications.

The contract will be a firm fixed price contract, with no adjustment for any escalation in costs or prices of labor or materials. Offeror will be responsible for determining the amount of labor and materials that will be required to complete the project, and for pricing its quotation accordingly.

The completion time is 120 working days for proposed **Fabrication, Supply and Installation of 12-kiloliter capacity Under Ground Petrol Storage Tanks**, commencing as per schedule provided in Notice to Proceed letter. In the event of an unauthorized or unexcused delay in completing the project, liquidated damages in the amount of **\$100** per calendar day will be assessed until substantial completion of the project is achieved.
