No quotation will be accepted after this date and time. Quotations submitted to another e-mail address shall not be taken into consideration. Quotations received after the due date and time shall be dealt with in accordance with the procedures in FAR provision 52.212-1(f).

The Contracting Officer reserves the right to reject any and all quotations and to waive any informality in quotations received. In addition, the Embassy reserves the right to establish a competitive range of one or more offerors and to conduct further

negotiations concerning price and other terms before awarding the contract, or to award without discussions.
