If you intend to submit a proposal, you should thoroughly examine all documents contained in the contract solicitation package. The Embassy intends to conduct a site visit (see L.6, 52.236-27). All prospective offerors who have received a solicitation package are invited to attend. The site visit will be held at American Embassy, Gate # 4/5, Annex building Shanti Path road, Chanakyapuri, New Delhi India on August 29, 2011 at 1100 hours. Submit any questions you may have concerning the solicitation documents in writing on August 25, 2011 latest by 1200 hrs. to the Contracting Officer, Ms. Monica E. Madrid at [MadridME@state.gov](mailto:MadridME@state.gov). Responses will be sent in writing to all contractors on our list of interested parties.

Prospective offerors who desire to participate in the site visit should contact the contracting officer at [madridME@state.gov](mailto:madridME@state.gov) or at fax number 91-11-24198278, **no later than 1000 hrs on August 26, 2011** for arranging entry of their participants into the building. No substitutions will be permitted later. **Complete names and designations of the individuals participating in the site visit should be provided, and the participants must carry a valid ID proof like driving license or passport or voter ID card during the site visit.**

Questions after the site visit may be sent to the Contracting Officer, Ms. Monica E. Madrid at [madridme@state.gov](mailto:madridme@state.gov) on or before 1400 hrs, August 30, 2011. Your proposal must be submitted in a sealed envelope marked "Proposal Enclosed" to the Contracting Officer - Monica E. Madrid at American Embassy, Gate # 'C', Chandragupta Marg, New Delhi - 110021 on or before 1500 hours on September 2, 2011. No proposal will be accepted after this time.

Complete the OFFER portion of the Standard Form 1442, including all blank spaces, and have the form signed by an authorized representative of your company, or the proposal may be considered unacceptable and may be rejected.

In order for a proposal to be considered, you must also complete and submit the following:

1. Section B and Attachment 1, Proposal Breakdown by Divisions;

2. Section K, Representations and Certifications;
3. Bar Chart illustrating sequence of work to be performed;
4. Additional information as required in Section L.

The contract will be a firm fixed price contract, with no adjustment for any escalation in costs or prices of labor or materials. Each offeror will be responsible for determining the amount of labor and materials that will be required to complete the project, and for pricing its proposal accordingly.


Please be advised that each offeror is responsible for furnishing complete information to its subcontractor and suppliers, such as details and quantities required by the drawings and specifications. Subcontractors and suppliers should not be referred to the Embassy or the Architect for determining the amount or quantities of materials required.

The construction completion time is 40 calendar days, commencing as per schedule provided in Notice to Proceed letter. In the event of an unauthorized or unexcused delay in completing the project, liquidated damages in the amount of \$618 per calendar day will be assessed until substantial completion of the project is achieved.

The Contracting Officer reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and to waive any informality in proposals received. In addition, the Embassy reserves the right to establish a competitive range of one or more offerors and to conduct further negotiations concerning price and other terms before awarding the contract, or to award without discussions.
