




Wildlife




Independence Day

The 1996 Pulitzer-Prize winning novel by Richard Ford demonstrates rare talent of a great American storyteller. His character, Frank Bascombe, has already earned a place in American literary landscape. In aftermath of his failed marriage and a failed career, Bascombe enters what he calls an "Existence Period." But Shh... over one Fourth of July weekend, he is all set to meet sudden, bewildering engagement with life.



The Lay of the Land

Tricky terrain of Frank Bascombe's life continues in this novel that dissects American life in the late twentieth century touching upon morality, faith, politics, and sex. Bascombe's story resumes in the fall of 2000 when his career in real estate is thriving and his life is supposedly on the right track. But as he grapples with marital and medical crisis, he has to find a new way to confront and sail through the unforeseen challenges of life.
