



STATEMENT OF WORK

DATABASE FOR INVESTMENT PROJECTS

Hire services to create database of the investment projects in the U.S. and its territories for the upcoming Select USA Road show in December 2012.

1. Contractor will solicit all 50 U.S. states and its territories and create the Database of the existing investment projects in the U.S. and its territories.
2. Contractor will execute a confidentiality agreement.
3. Each such investment project will be at least US\$1,000,000 and the Database listing will provide a brief description of the project, its location and the contact details of the promoters.
4. The database shall not include real estate properties for sale unless it is a business investment such as a hotel or a restaurant or an office, warehouse or factory building.
5. The Database may be accessible online or assembled on a CD.
6. The Database will be available to all participants and guests attending the events during the Road Show (whether distributing CDs or brochures or making online access available).
7. For all the purposes the Database will be owned jointly by FCS India and Contractor, and both FCS India and Contractor may use its contents and contact the project promoters during, before and after the Road Show as they please.
8. Contractor complete and deliver the Database electronically and on a CD to FCS India on or before November 15, 2012.
9. Contractor may include its business contacts and potential investors as guest for all of the Road Show events; provided that such guests or investors are preapproved by FCS India.
10. Contractor may deliver one presentation in each city of the Road Show; provided that the content of such presentation is agreed to by FCS India.
11. Contractor will be free to market its services and products to the participants of the Road Show through networking, and distribution of marketing material and attaching its brand to the Database.
12. If needed, FCS India may engage contractor to set up match-making meetings during the Road Show, and such match-making services will be governed by a separate agreement or a purchase order executed by the contractor and FCS India.
