

## E-Teacher scholarship program announcement

The Regional English Language Office (RELO) of the U.S. Embassy in New Delhi is pleased to invite nominations for a ten-week online professional development course for teachers of English in India on “Building Teaching Skills through the Interactive Web”.

This course will be offered in the U.S. Fall term (October 1- December 7, 2012)

For selection, we highlight the importance of the following requirements:

- (a) At least an upper-intermediate level in English (equivalent to IELTS band 7 or above)
- (b) Regular and dependable access to the Internet and e-mail
- (c) **Commitment to spend the necessary 10-15 hours/week throughout the 10-week course**
- (d) Familiarity with the Internet, e-mail and MS Office

### **Recruitment**

Candidates for this Scholarship should be teacher trainers or teachers who are working, or plan to work, with using web tools, with their secondary, senior secondary, or tertiary level English language students. They should be highly motivated individuals who are dedicated both to their own professional development and to sharing the knowledge gained with colleagues through workshops or professional presentations.

### **Course fees**

- the course will include an evaluation component
