- Must use Dual Ion Mobility Spectrometry (IMS) Technology
- Have a minimum of three (3) operating modes; Explosive/Narcotics, Explosives only, and Narcotics only
- Will detect at a minimum; Cocaine, Heroin, Amphetamine, Methamphetamine, MDA, and THC
- Analysis time will be no longer than 10 seconds
- Warm up time will be no longer than 33 minutes
- Must have a built-in printer
- Voltage: 110/220

- b) Technical Acceptability. Technical acceptability will include a review of items listed under Article B in Section 3.

c) Price Evaluation. The lowest price will be determined by price comparison among the technically acceptable and responsible offerors. The Government reserves the right to reject proposals that are unreasonably low or high in price.

d) Term of Payment. Government term of payment is **nett-30 days** upon received the item/s and proper invoice. There is no *down payment* (DP) prior to delivery of all required goods.
