<p><b>Specification :</b></p> <p><b>Leptospira IgM test, Quantity : 500 box (10 tes/box)</b></p> <p><i>Rapid testing tool for the detection of antibodies against Leptospira interrogans in serum or blood samples qualitatively. Only used by health professionals.</i></p> <p>TEST Leptospira IgM an immunological rapid test equipment chromatographic. Test line is sprayed on top of the membrane. This tool is nitrocellulose <b>lipopolysaccharide</b> antigen taken from the culture of Leptospira bacteria. In the conjugate pad there were anti-human IgM antibodies labeled with red gold colloid particles. To do testing, samples of serum or blood shed in the hole samples. Furthermore dripped buffer solution for push the sample. Specific antibodies in samples against pathogens will be attached to the LPS antigen and These antibodies will then bind to the colloidal particles gold and colored. The presence of specific antibodies to characterized by the appearance of red in the test line. If the sample does not contain specific antibodies against pathogens, sample and buffer solution will move past test line so as not to cause the color. Whereas control line should always appear in any sample. The appearance of the control line indicates that the test tool works well.</p> <p>Packaging            1 Box @ 10 TEST Leptospira IgM, pipette transfer and 3 mL of buffer solution and lancet.
