PURPOSE

This is a U.S. Consulate General in Erbil Pre-Proposal Special Notice only. Contractors are requested to read the below requirements. No responses are requested by this notice. The U.S. Consulate General in Erbil issues this notice with the intent of giving an opportunity to all interested parties to appropriately prepare for the anticipated Request for Proposal (RFP).

This is not a request for proposal; this is for pre-solicitation / informational purposes only. No award will be made on the basis of responses received to this notice.

BACKGROUND

The U.S. Consulate General Erbil has a requirement for repair of 72 and clean up of 144 Containerized Housing Units at the Erbil Diplomatic Support Center.

PROPOSED CONTRACT ACTION

The Contractor shall provide the service as described herein to meet the critical mission requirements of the U.S. Consulate General Erbil.

10. Place of Performance: Iraqi Kurdistan Region, Republic of Iraq
11. Special contract requirements:
 - a) The Contractor shall possess all permits, licenses, and any other appointments required for the prosecution of work under this contract.
