

PRE-RFP Notice: DFAC Site Improvements at the U. S. Embassy Compound, Baghdad, Iraq

PURPOSE

This is a U.S. Embassy Baghdad Pre-Proposal Special Notice only. Contractors are requested to read the below requirements. No responses are requested by this notice. The U.S. Embassy Baghdad issues this notice with the intent of giving an opportunity to all interested parties to appropriately prepare for the anticipated Request for Proposal (RFP).

This is not a request for proposal; this is for pre-solicitation / informational purposes only. No award will be made on the basis of responses received to this notice.

BACKGROUND

The U.S. Embassy Baghdad has a requirement for General Construction Services for the improvement of the DFAC site at the U. S. Embassy Compound, Baghdad, Iraq.

PROPOSED CONTRACT ACTION

The Contractor shall provide services as described herein to meet the critical mission requirements of the U.S. Embassy Baghdad.

Accordingly, the U.S. Embassy Baghdad plans the issuance of the following solicitation (RFP):
