Enclosed is a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Security T-Walls at the U.S. Embassy Baghdad, Iraq. If you would like to submit a proposal, follow the instructions in Section L of the attached Request for Proposal (RFP).

The U.S. Government intends to award a contract to the responsible company submitting an acceptable offer at the lowest price. We intend to award a contract based on initial proposals, without holding discussions, although we may hold discussions with companies in the competitive range if there is a need to do so.

Your proposal must be submitted electronically by email with the subject line "**Proposal S-IZ100-12-R-0050 Enclosed**" exclusively to [BaghdadGSOProcBid@state.gov](mailto:BaghdadGSOProcBid@state.gov) on or before 12:00 noon (Baghdad Time) on **September 4<sup>th</sup>, 2012**. You may also elect to submit your proposal in hard copy marked for the attention of the "**Contracting Officer – Proposal S-IZ100-12-R-0050 Enclosed**", which may be delivered to the Embassy Red CAC on Al Kindi Street between 0800 and 1500 on regular business days. No proposals will be considered if delivered to any other addresses than those stated above, and no proposals will be accepted after the solicitation closing date and time.

Complete the OFFER portion of the **Standard Form 1442**, including all blank spaces, and have the form signed by authorized representative of your company, or the proposal may be considered unacceptable and may be rejected.

In order for a proposal to be considered, you must also complete and submit the following:

- 1- **Section B.1 Contract Price and Bid Form;**
- 2- **Attachment #4-Breakdown of Proposal by Price by Division of Specification;**
- 3- **Section K, Representations and Certifications;**
- 4- **Bar Chart illustrating sequence of work to be performed;**
- 5- **Additional information as required in Section L;**

The contract will be a firm-fixed price contract, with no adjustment for any escalation in costs or prices of labor or materials. Each offeror will be responsible for determining the amount of labor and materials that will be required to complete the project, and for pricing its proposal accordingly.

Please be advised that each offeror is responsible for furnishing complete information to its subcontractors and suppliers, such as details and quantities required by the drawings and specifications. Subcontractors and suppliers should not be referred to the Embassy or the Architect for determining the amount or quantities of materials required.

The construction completion time is **75 calendar days** commencing on date of notice to proceed. In the event of an unauthorized or unexcused delay in completing the project, liquidated damages in the amount of ***IQD 1,242,857.00*** per calendar day will be assessed until substantial completion of the project is achieved.

The contracting Officer reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and to waive any informality in proposals received. In addition, the Embassy reserves the right to establish a competitive range of one or more offerors and to conduct further negotiations concerning price and other terms before awarding the contract, or to award without discussions.
