The American Embassy **Baghdad, Iraq** has a requirement for a contractor to provide **Wireless Internet Service to be placed in a common area located on the U.S. Consulate grounds in Basrah, Iraq**. You are invited to submit a quotation. The Request for Quotations (RFQ) consists of the following sections:

1. Standard Form SF-1449
2. Basic information, statement of work or specifications and technical qualifications
3. Contract Clauses and Solicitation Provisions
4. Late quotation rules and evaluation method

The Embassy plans to award a purchase order. You are encouraged to make your quotation competitive. You are also cautioned against any collusion with other potential offerors with regard to price quotations to be submitted. The RFQ does not commit the American Embassy to make any award. The Embassy may cancel this RFQ or any part of it.

Please read the RFQ carefully, filled required blocks in the SF1449 and prices in the solicitation package and if you are interested, submit your quotation. Oral quotations will not be accepted.

In order for a quotation to be considered, you must complete and submit the following:

1. SF 1449 (required blocks to be filled in)
2. Section 1-Prices III
3. Section 5, Representation and Certification
4. All additional information as required in Section 4-Evaluation Factors

Your proposal must be submitted electronically by email with the subject line "**Quotation S-IZ100-13-Q-0051 Enclosed**" to BaghdadGSOProcBid@state.gov on **or before 12:00 noon (Baghdad Time) on December 11th, 2012**. You may also elect to submit your proposal in hard copy marked for the attention of the "**Contracting Officer – Proposal S-IZ100-13-Q-0051 Enclosed**", which may be delivered to the Embassy Red CAC on Al Kindi Street between 0800 and 1500 on regular business days. No proposal will be accepted after the cut-off date and time.

Quotation submitted to any other email address than BaghdadGSOProcBid@state.gov will be rejected according to FAR 3.104-4 Disclosure, protection and marking of contractor bid or proposal information and source selection information.

The Contracting Officer reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and to waive any informality in proposals received. In addition, the Embassy reserves the right to establish a

competitive range of one or more offerors and to conduct further negotiations concerning price and other terms before awarding the contract, or to award without discussions.
