You may also submit your quotation in hard copy marked to the attention of the "**Contracting Officer – Quotation S-IZ100-13-Q-1015 Enclosed**" to the U.S. Embassy Red CAC on Al Kindi Street between 0800 and 1500 on regular business days (Sunday through Thursday). No quotation will be accepted after the cut-off date and time.

In order for a quotation to be considered, you must complete and submit the following:

1. Section 1;
2. Section 5, Representations and Certifications;
3. All additional information as required in Section 3 and Section 4.

The U.S. Government reserves the right to reject any and all quotations and to waive any informality in quotations received.

The U.S. Government intends to award a contract to the responsible company submitting an acceptable quotation at the lowest price technically acceptable. We intend to award a contract based on initial quotations, without holding discussions, although we may hold discussions with companies in the competitive range if there is a need to do so.
