

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q1. Is it mandatory to submit a proposal for all required CLINS or can the contractor choose to submit a proposal for certain CLINS only?

A1. Please refer to Section 4 – Evaluation Factors, last paragraph.

Q2. Regarding CLIN 0006, we do not see the reason for providing /28 static IP addresses. We understand this requirement as a (transmission pipe of 10Mbps capacity) between the Embassy & BDSC which the USG will use for voice & data traffic. Please clarify.

A2. The CLIN does state /28 static IP addresses, which is standard language for our circuit paths. However in this case, you are correct, we are asking for a Layer-2 Point-to-Point connection that should NOT require any IP addresses. This CLIN is for the vendor to provide the USG with a pass-through median for our equipment to continually transmit/receive 10MB of data with less than a 10MS roundtrip delay.
