USCIS KINGSTON, JAMAICA CHECKLIST FOR SUBMISSION OF FORM I-601 APPLICATION FOR WAIVER OF GROUNDS OF INADMISSIBILITY

- Form I-601 – Application for Waiver of Grounds of Inadmissibility**
 - Type the form or print legibly using block letters.
 - Dates must be listed in month/day/year format; March 20, 2007 should be written as **03/20/07**.
 - Item 10a – Please check all items that apply to your situation regarding inadmissibility.
 - Page 3 – Please describe in your own words why you are inadmissible – if you require additional space; use a blank piece of paper for a continuation sheet.
 - Item 11 – Please list all of your entries into the United States – use continuation sheet if more room is required.
 - Section B and C – List all qualifying relatives in the United States; e.g, spouse, parent, child, fiancé(e), etc.
 - Section D – Must be dated and signed by applicant or qualified relative. **Unsigned applications cannot be accepted.**
 - Item E – To be completed if application is completed by any individual other than applicant or qualified family member, whether assistance was paid or voluntary.
- Form I-212 – Application for Permission to Reapply for Admission into the United States After Deportation or Removal**
 - Type the form or print legibly using block letters.
 - Dates must be listed in month/day/year format; March 20, 2007 should be written as **03/20/07**.
 - Section 19 – Must be signed by applicant **ONLY**. **Unsigned applications cannot be accepted.**
- Required Fee of \$585.00**
 - Payment for ***each application*** must be completed with the Consular Cashier before submission:
 - If filing by mail
 - International Money Order in U.S. dollars, payable to Department of Homeland Security
 - Manager's Check in U.S. dollars, payable to Department of Homeland Security
 - Please include case number and applicant name on enclosed check(s).
 - If filing in person
 - By credit card
 - By cash, either US dollars or the equivalent in Jamaican dollars
- Supporting Documentation:**
 - Official Translations.** Documents in any language other than English must be accompanied by an accurate English translation. The translator must certify that he or she is competent to translate from the foreign language into English and that the translation is complete and accurate.
 - Extreme Hardship of Qualifying Family Member** (if applicable) – Hardship statement from the applicant's United States Citizen or Permanent Resident qualifying relative. The statement should explain why the inability of the applicant to reside in the United States would cause "extreme hardship" to the qualifying relative; the nature of the hardships, and why the qualifying relative cannot reside with the applicant outside of the United States. Statement should be supported by documentary evidence. **See Waiver Information Sheet for more details.**
 - Rehabilitation/Reformation Statement** (if applicable) – If inadmissibility is based on criminal grounds and crimes occurred 15 years or more before the date of application, applicant must provide a statement discussing describing in detail his/her evidence of rehabilitation and reformation.
 - Court records/Police certificates** (if applicable) – If inadmissibility is based on criminal grounds, applicant should provide all court records, case disposition documents, and police certificates relating to the offense(s) that caused your inadmissibility.
 - Form G-325A (Biographic Information)** Provide only one form for applicant and one form for qualifying family member. Do not submit multiple copies. Do not leave any fields blank; complete all blocks. If not applicable, enter "Not Applicable" or "NA". The applicant must sign his/her own form; the qualifying family member must sign his/her own form.

ORDER OF DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED

You should submit your I-601 package in the following order

- On top – Checklist for Petition for I-601
- Proof of fee payment
- G-28 – Notice of Entry of Appearance as Attorney or Representative (only if applicable);
- I-601 – Application for Waiver of Grounds of Inadmissibility
- I-212 – Application for Permission to Reapply for Admission into the United States After Deportation or Removal (if applicable)
- G-325A – Biographic Information for applicant (submission is optional)
- G-325A – Biographic Information for qualifying relative (submission is optional)
- Copy of medical exam (applicable for medical inadmissibility only)
- Extreme Hardship Statement and supporting documentation
- Rehabilitation/Reformation Statement from Applicant (if applicable)
- Police Certificates/court records (if applicable)
