



America House Grant Opportunities: **Call for Proposals**

America House is currently conducting a call for project proposals. The mission of America House is to encourage a dialogue between the United States and Jerusalemites in order to foster mutual understanding and emphasize shared values.

America House supports and encourages initiatives that focus on any of the following priority areas:

- Improve mutual understanding or cultural exchange between Jerusalemites and Americans or;
- Target an area of need in the local community or;
- Promote dialogue among different groups from Jerusalem.

The grants can be awarded in amounts up to a maximum of \$10,000. Applications that include cost sharing, creative techniques to reduce costs, and multiple partners will receive favorable consideration.

Format:

Grantees should submit proposals (in English or Arabic) outlining the project, and should include the following:

- Name of applicant organization, contact person and full contact information, and project title.
- An executive summary of the project (What do you propose to do and how?)
- Project objectives (What would the project accomplish?)
- Targeted group/beneficiaries of the project.
- Budget (in USD), including cost sharing.
- Full listing of project essential staff, including CVs/resumes

General rules for proposal submission:

1. Projects should be implemented in Jerusalem, or involve primarily Jerusalemite participants.

2. Only one proposal per organization will be accepted.
3. Project budget should not exceed \$10,000.
4. Priority will be given to creative and innovative projects.

Deadline: Proposals should be submitted no later than January 15, 2011.
