English for Presentations is a 21 hour course that provides learners at the Pre-Intermediate/Intermediate (2B/3A) level with the language and techniques to help them present effectively in English.

The course has six units which cover the language and skills involved at each stage of a presentation. Other related topics are also addressed, such as:

1. Dealing with nervousness
2. Interacting with an audience
3. Body language
4. Creating effective visuals
5. Describing graphs, charts and trends
6. Presenting to an English-speaking audience.

Each unit includes authentic excerpts from presentations with listening activities, gap-fills, and exercises to help students learn and practice specific expressions and structures.

By the end of this course, you will be able to:

- Deliver a concrete presentation in English using various techniques in an appropriate manner
- Conclude a presentation successfully
- Handle the Question/Answer session following the presentation.
