


Growing in Your Intercultural Understanding

Over the course of seven weeks, we will explore the concepts of communication, culture, and intercultural competence in a discussion-based format. Each class session will discuss information in a straightforward way, moving from theory to personal application.

We will draw significantly from **Intercultural Communication: Unity in Diversity**. This recently published book presents intercultural communication from a Middle Eastern perspective. The authors, 6 Arab professors and 1 American scholar, collaborated to produce a text that not only fosters tolerance of others, but takes the reader to a higher level of appreciation for diversity.

This course will:

- ❖ Lay a foundation for understanding communication and appreciating culture.
- ❖ Focus on understanding cultural differences and learning important skills related to competent intercultural communication.
- ❖ Discuss challenges to intercultural competence such as stereotyping, prejudice, and racism.
- ❖ Provide participants with avenues to grow as competent intercultural communicators, including personal evaluation and increased interaction with others from diverse cultural backgrounds.
