PROJECT:

SERVICES OF LOCAL CONTRACTOR ARE REQUIRED FOR INTERIOR AND EXTERIOR PAINT WORKS AT 1-FJR OF OLD CGR FRERE HALL AREA KARACHI.

WORK OUT LINE:

Services of contractor are required to carry out Interior and Exterior Paint and Polish work of old CGR at Frere Hall 1-Fatima Jinnah Road. Painting/Polish Contractor which will be used to do the paint and polish work of all interior/exterior surfaces at the 1 Fatima Jinnah Road.

WORK FORCE:

Services of one of the Painting/Polish Contractor will be used to do the paint and polish work of old CG's residences.

Health and Safety requirement

The contractor shall and agrees to comply with any and the US Consulate may require health and safety regulations as during the performance of this work.

Health and Safety requirement,

Personnel Health Requirements

All employees shall be in good general health without physical disabilities that would interfere with acceptable performance of their duties. All employees shall be free from communicable diseases.

Supervision.

The Contractor shall provide all supervision of the work. A Consulate Maintenance Staff Supervisor will inspect the work on a daily basis to insure that work meets the requirements of the Contract. He will indicate errors and corrections required to the Contractor's Supervisor.

Escort of Contractor Personnel:

The US Consulate will provide a work escort for work accomplished on USG properties and within our security Zones. Work accomplished outside our Security Zone will be not be escorted.

Scope of work for exterior paint:

The contractor will carry out the following works as per site requirement.

Exterior:

- Contractor is responsible to match the paint color of the exterior to the color of the current brick-Ramie for the current exterior part that is painted and also for all fences and walls.
 - The existing brick in the front of the house will not to be painted. Contractor is responsible to paint the White trim around the windows and molding and remove the excess white that is currently painted on the brick.
 - Screened in porch (exterior)-Rustic Leather
 - Accents around the pool area (currently painted blue)-Kind Sky
 - Note: - For exterior no pressure wash and sandblasting is required.
1. Contractor shall responsible for providing jutan paint to match with the bricks color, oil paint polish material, Plaster of Paris, filling material, sanding papers, sand, cement, or any other type of painting and Mainer masonry repair related material, complete in all aspect as per site requirements.
Jutan weather shield paint, and re-paint all painted surfaces and Dana polish all wood surfaces on the entire property including the main residence, staff quarters and toilets, garage, guard booths, screened-in porch, perimeter walls, metal grills, wooden doors, metal doors, window, roto gate, and other frames, and other surfaces as required. The contractor shall apply paint and Dana polish to obtain the required shade and a smooth (drip free) surface, regardless of the number of coats needed to do the job in a professional manner as per site requirements.
 2. The contractor shall be responsible for completing any masonry repairs, speckling, and other preparatory patching before re-painting.
 3. The contractor shall thoroughly scrape, brush, sanding, wash, or otherwise clean all surfaces to remove loose paint, dirt, and rust. (All metalwork shall be primed with rust resistant paint and then painted in a professional manner.)
 4. The contractor shall be responsible for protecting all plants, glass, sidewalks, floors, fixtures, furniture, and other unpainted surfaces from paint drips, spillage, and spots occasioned by the work. Where necessary, painters must use drop cloths and all incidents of spilled paint shall be addressed immediately upon their discovery.
 5. As the last step in the proposed work, the contractor shall clean all exterior glass surfaces. The work shall not be considered completed and payable unless and until this final step is accomplished.
 7. The contractor shall keep the site clean and tidy at all times and all waste material shall be promptly removed from the premises.
 8. The contractor shall arrange, at contractor's expense, all material tools including but not limited to ladders, scaffolding, brushes, paint roller, power

sending machine, scrapers, wire brushes, baby grainder, etc. needed to do the work.

9. The contractor shall be responsible for replacement or repair of any property damaged by himself or his workers.

Interior painting Scope of work:

The designated contractor shall complete works as per the requirements listed below:

Contractor is responsible to use the Nippon paint color listed or comparable.

All ceilings, moldings and columns will remain White
Entryway, all hallways (both floors), stairs and lounge-Green Whimsey
Dining room-Knockout Red (dark red/burgundy to match the carpet and chairs) with White trim
Living/sitting/piano room (front of house)-Spring Blossom
Downstairs bathrooms-Snowbush Rose
Office/downstairs workspace- Beige
Kitchen and back of the house space- White
Sindh room- Ash White
Sindh room bathroom-Summer Day
Amb suite- Ash White
Amb suite bathroom- Summer Day
AIC suite- Ash White
AIC bathroom- Summer Day
CG's bedroom-Ash White
CG's bathroom-Summer Day
Screened in porch- Rustic Leather for side that faces out and Kind Sky with White trim for side that faces interior.

- All surfaces in the house including walls, ceilings, cabinets and conduit, or piping on the exterior of the walls and ceilings will be repainted.
- All surfaces to be painted will be removed of loose paint, plaster, dirt, grease or any other substance that would prevent the paint from properly adhering to the surface.
- All imperfections in the walls and ceilings will be filled with a quality patching material to give the surface a smooth and even appearance when painted.
- Masonry walls and ceilings will be covered with quality ICI emulsion paint, so that all surfaces present a solid color surface with no bubbling, spotting or bare wall areas where the subsurface can be seen through the finish.
- All wood surfaces (all windows doors cabinets, stairs railing, window louvers,) in the kitchens, bedroom, hallways, porch, store, closets, and baths will painted with a quality gloss oil based paint or Dana Polish, completed in all aspect as per site requirement.
