**THIS ANNOUNCEMENT IS FOR THE PURPOSES OF SOLICITING CONTRACTORS INTERESTED IN SUBMITTING AN OFFER IN THE BELOW DESCRIBED CONTRACTS FOR THE US ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS, MIDDLE EAST DISTRICT.**

- 1. PROJECT NAME AND LOCATION: Canine Training Facility , Almaty, Kazakhstan; Counternarcotics (CN) Training Facility, Almaty, Kazakhstan (two projects in one contract)**

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Canine Training Center:** Construct a 791 SM (8514 SF), two story, multi-purpose building and support facilities. Conference center includes training rooms for up to 80 personnel, classrooms, and living quarters for three teachers and 10 students. The 791 SM includes 103 SM of covered walkway; training center building is 688 SM.

**CN Training Center:** Construct a 441 SM (4747 SF) single story multipurpose training facility with four classrooms sized for 30 persons each, and a conference room accommodating up to 50 persons.

The Contractor will perform a topographic survey and a geotechnical investigation. The Contractor will also be responsible for site improvements; water supply and distribution; sewage leach fields; and miscellaneous storm water drainage structures. The Contractor's work will include the preparation of construction design documents as noted in the request for proposal scope of work. The Contractor will construct structures, utilities, cables, control debris, etc. required to provide fully functional facilities.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTIONS:** Custom Post Scanner Facility: Construct a Vehicle Scanner Building and support facilities. The building for housing the scanner equipment is a 4,782 square foot (444 square meters) structure. Supporting Facilities. The contract includes site preparation, extension and connection of utilities, and perimeter fencing. The scanner equipment will be purchased and installed by another contractor.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTIONS:** Multi Operations Center: Construct an inter-regional operations center building and supporting facilities. The operations center building is designed as a 3,384 square foot (317 square meters) structure. Facilities in the building include a special investigation office, classified information office, duty officer station, small arms locker, conference room, exercise/training room and restrooms/showers. Separate structures include a 2,196 square foot (204 square meters) 4-bay garage with inspection pit. Supporting Facilities. Contract includes site preparation, an access drive and parking, extension and connection of utilities, and perimeter fencing.

Canine Center Facility: Constructs a two story multipurpose Canine Center Building and supporting structures. The building will be a 220 SM (2368 SF) structure to support 20 Full Time Equivalents (FTEs) and consists of office spaces , canine food preparation room, sleeping rooms, and other general administrative space. Supporting work includes demolition of an existing structure, site preparation, and extension and connection of utilities.
