Representatives of the U.S. Embassy Consular Section will be available on Monday, April 11, 2011 from 14:00 to 18:00 at **Tengizchevroil Headquarters (3 Satpayev Street, Room 121G, Atyrau)** to answer general consular questions and provide basic consular services such as notaries, affidavits, certification of true copies, passport applications and I-130 petitions (to start the immigrant visa process for relatives of American citizens resident in Kazakhstan)

- If you wish **additional pages** to be inserted into your passport, please send a scanned copy of application form DS-4085 no later than 10 a.m. on Thursday, April 7, 2011 by email to USAKZ@state.gov. **Bring the original form and your passport to the meeting.**
- If you would like to apply for **passports for a child:** both parents and the child must appear in person to sign a passport application form.
- If you would like to apply for a **passport renewal**, please fill out an application form and submit your current passport.
- If you would like to have a **notarial** service, please prepare the form you need to sign and bring your ID.
- If you would like to apply for Consular Report of Birth Abroad (CRBA): either parent and the child must come to submit an application form.
