Warden Message: Civil Unrest in Kyrgyzstan

Due to the recent civil unrest in Talas, Kyrgyzstan on April 6, 2010 and Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan on April 7, 2010, the U.S. Consulate General in Almaty has canceled travel of Embassy staff to Kyrgyzstan until further notice. News reports indicate that clashes between protestors and police have been violent. Private American citizens planning to travel to Kyrgyzstan should exercise extreme caution and should consider deferring travel there until the situation has improved.
