Water Well Project PWS

Contractor personnel will provide all materials, tools, equipment, and manpower to drill boreholes and install hand-pumps.

The following work will be completed at this location:

- a. Hydrologic survey at specified location.
- b. Drill, develop, and seal well at specified location.
- c. Well is to be drilled to a minimum depth (to provide a proper sanitary seal) and a maximum static water level (deepest level accessible by hand-pump) indicated by the results of the hydrologic survey.
- d. Construct well base and trough (to direct runoff) for the well site.
- e. Install hand pump for location.
- f. In cooperation and coordination with the CA team, provide training to the local village and/or water committee on setup, installation, management, and maintenance of hand pump.
- g. Provide CJ-34 a copy of all boring logs and well drilling data.

CJTF-HOA CJ-34 Engineers are responsible to provide quality assurance, quality control and technical expertise as required.

Civil Affairs (CA) personnel will maintain contact with the local Government/ leaders. CA personnel will take the lead and encourage the local leaders/managers of the community to attend the Operational and Maintenance (O&M) training upon completion of each project.

The following factors should be considered during the planning and execution of this project:

1. Rainy season begins in April and ends in September.
2. Traversing dirt roads may be an issue due to washouts and mud zones.
3. All sites will have to be accessed via riverbed crossings.
4. All wells shall be completed no later than 30 APR 2013.

- a. Drill 1 new well with handpump in the vicinity of: 10.839512°N 048.931860°E

*The rainy season begins around mid April and ends around September with August being the wettest.
