The U.S. Embassy Warehouse will be holding an auction on **Thursday, May 23, 2013 at 10:00 a.m and it's open to the public.**

Auctioneers: Antique Auctions Ltd. will conduct the sale on behalf of the U.S. Embassy.

Venue: Mugoya Godowns, Embakasi. Same Entrance as the KQ's - The Pride Centre. A sign post belonging to Antique Auctions will be posted at the main gate.

Deposits: All bidders and general public must pay a banker's check deposit of KES 50,000 for furniture, KES 200,000 for vehicles, KES 250,000 for furniture and vehicles to CBA, before they can bid. This is to ensure that only serious bidders participate in the auction.

Payments: After the sale, you may make cash payments to the Auction Account at Commercial Bank of Africa (CBA) in the name of Antique Auctions. For all purchase payments, please state your catalogue (customer) number on the paying slip when you present your payment.

Viewing Dates/Times: May 20 - 22, 2013 from 9:30am to 4:00pm

Catalogs will be available for sale at the entrance of the auction room priced at KES 500.

After the auction, collection of the winning bids will be on Friday May 24, 2013, and from, Monday May 27, to Wednesday May 29, from 9.00am – 4.00pm. Please note that items can only be collected after full payment.
