Singin' in the Rain's Don (Gene Kelly) is a star who never forgot his humble beginnings; he remains unimpressed with the trappings of success. Don's love interest, Kathy (Debbie Reynolds), struggles to make it in the entertainment industry. Together, they try to transition from silent films to "talkies." Singin' in the Rain is one of Hollywood's most influential films. In 2006, the American Film Institute named it the greatest movie musical of all time. Gene Kelly's legendary dance scene will have viewers begging for a summer shower so they can skip through the streets and appreciate the beautiful things in life.



Roman Holiday features Joe (Gregory Peck), an imperfect hero who struggles with a moral dilemma when he is presented with the opportunity of a lifetime. His professional success could mean betraying the trust of the unforgettable Ann (Audrey Hepburn). The film underscores the simple charms of life outside of royalty through Hepburn's enchanting performance. Roman Holiday was Hepburn's first major American film and catapulted her to stardom as she won an Academy Award, Golden Globe, and BAFTA for her performance.
